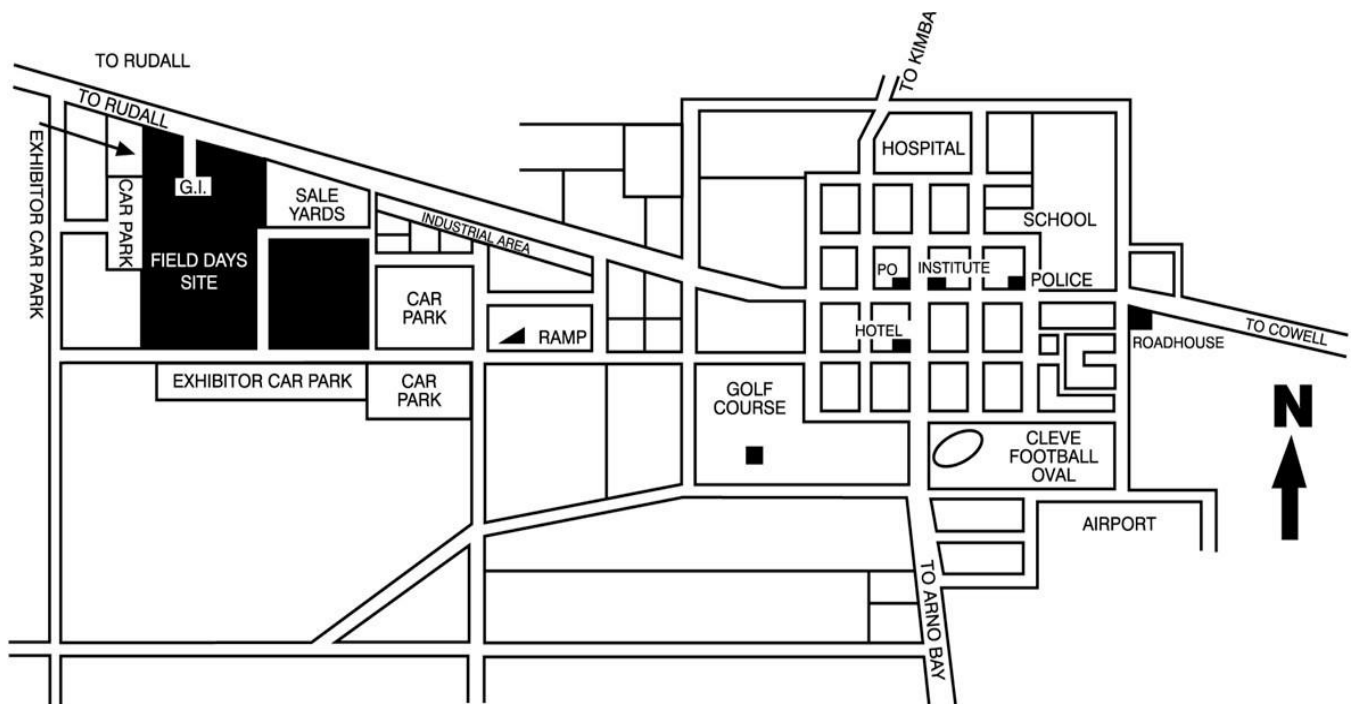

Exhibitor Information

Airstrip

The Cleve all weather airstrip is situated 3kms east of the site. A courtesy vehicle is available to and from the airport and town. Please advise the office of your requirements.

Catering

During the Field Days exhibitors may only provide coffee/tea and biscuits and/or light refreshments. Full meals are not permitted. Exhibitors providing light refreshments must adhere to health regulations covering food – note Section 62(3)(b) of the Health Act. **STRICTLY NO URNS OR COFFEE MACHINES – JUGS ONLY.** Exhibitors not complying within these requirements may have their site approval revoked under terms and conditions clause 25. We recommend that you utilise one of the official on-site caterers. There will be on site catering for exhibitors from Monday August 10th. The Eyre Peninsula Field Day committee must be notified (on the application form) that you intend to have light refreshments on your site and the **Cleve District Council must approve it.** Liquor Licenses are the responsibility of the site holder and must be approved prior to the event.

Closing Date for Applications

All applications and payments must be received by **July 1st, 2020 or a \$80.00 late fee applies.** The Eyre Peninsula Field Days will be offering an early bird discount of 10%, for all applications received prior to the 31st May 2020.

Communications

Only 3G/4G is available through Optus and Telstra. All good signal. EFTPOS systems will only work on these networks appropriately configured. Fixed line services are available, **REQUEST MUST BE MADE** on the site application form. This provides dialup service to analogue EFTPOS systems. There are several Wi-Fi hotspots, but these are not suitable for EFTPOS systems because of security issues.

Courier

A courier service will be available for goods weighing more than 5 kg or awkward to carry. To include your company in this free service, this must be indicated on your application form.

Danger

Under no circumstances is digging of holes or driving in of pegs allowed on your site before **checking** with power and communications officers through the Secretary's office to ensure there are no power cables, PA cables or water pipes in the vicinity. All services will be marked with a red line.

Displays

All displays must be in place by 5.00pm on Monday, of the Field Days and **must not be removed before 4.30pm on Thursday.** No access to site after 6pm. Large displays, particularly, need to be set up as early as possible to ensure easy access to the site.

Dogs

Due to public health & safety issues, no dogs will be allowed on site (Service Dogs excepted).

EFTPOS

An EFTPOS cash out facility is available next to main Admin office, D Road.

Emergency Services

St Johns, Police, Country Fire Service and State Emergency Services will all be in attendance. Contact the office should you require any of these services.

Exhibitor Passes

All exhibitors attending the Eyre Peninsula Field Days will require a three-day pass at \$20.00 each. Please indicate the number of passes you require on the application form. **(Please note that no passes are included in site fees).** Exhibitor passes can be collected from the office until 6pm Monday 28th September. If you do not have a pass by this time it is your responsibility to organise with your site manager to have a pass left at the exhibitor gate to be collected upon your arrival.

Gate Times

Gates will be open for exhibitors at 7.00am and closed at 6.00pm. There will be no camping on site or adjacent car parks by exhibitors. Public gate times are from 8.00am to 5.30pm. In the interest of public safety, **NO VEHICLES WILL BE PERMITTED TO ENTER OR EXIT THE DISPLAY AREAS PRIOR TO 4.30PM ON THURSDAY AUGUST 14TH.**

Exhibitor Information

Gas

Site holders must abide by the WH&S STANDARDS for the use of gas bottles inside marquees. Exhibitors must apply for permission from the committee.

New Releases

Please indicate on your application form of any new releases by your company to be eligible for New Release Awards (awards apply to agricultural releases only).

Livestock

Livestock are permitted on site only with the express permission from the committee. Refer to the application form should you require sheep for demonstration or water for your livestock.

Parking

Parking areas for exhibitors are provided north-west and south of the site (refer to maps on pages 4 & 8). Exhibitors will be provided with vehicle display stickers to access these parking areas. **DUE TO SAFETY CONCERNS REGARDING VEHICLES ON SITE, ACCESS WILL BE RESTRICTED.** An application for one site pass can be arranged on collection of information pack at main site office. **Vehicles will be allowed access to the site each morning and must be returned to the exhibitor parking area before 9.00am – unless the vehicle is part of your display.**

Payment of Fees

All prices listed on the application form are GST inclusive. Payment will be accepted via Direct Deposit, Cheque, Visa, and MasterCard. Your application WILL NOT be accepted if the total amount including GST is not paid.

Power

Due to overloading problems, **ALL ELECTRIC URNS, COFFEE MACHINES & SPACE HEATERS ARE BANNED.** Small electric kettles and microwaves are permitted. It is **ESSENTIAL** to indicate power requirements on the application form. All power outlets have 10amp breakers fitted. Exhibitors are to provide their own onsite extension cords (max 15m). All cords and appliances **MUST HAVE CURRENT TEST TAGS ATTACHED.**

Premium Site Surcharge

Corner sites on inside rows in pavilions are regarded as “premium sites” due to increased passing foot traffic and attract a 20% surcharge.

Public Address Advertising

Advertising over our public address system is available for the duration of the Field Days. Two (2) x 30 second advertisements per day per exhibitor will be allowed. See page 16. Further details and costing are on the application form. Free advertisements are available to announce on-site demonstrations.

Public Liability Insurance

Public Liability is incorporated within the site fees.

Ramp

A public loading ramp is available 24/7. Please refer to the map on page 4 for the location.

Safety Watch

All personnel and vehicles must be off site each night by 6pm. Safety Watch will then commence until 7am each morning, starting Monday 10th August, to Friday morning 14th August. Exhibitors are responsible for their site security from 7am to 6pm daily.

Site Sharing

Exhibitors who have other firms on their site must ensure that the firm concerned is entered on the Site Application Form. A site sharing fee of \$100.00 (GST inclusive) per additional exhibitor applies and payment must be made to the Eyre Peninsula Field Days Inc. as requested via Tax Invoice.

Work Health & Safety

All Exhibitors and their employees must abide by the Occupational Health and Safety Act, as applies in SA. Refer to Terms and Conditions on pages 17 for specific additional information. The site allocated is considered an extension of the exhibitors' workplace. You and the Eyre Peninsula Field Days have responsibility for the safety of staff and visitors to your site. A material safety data sheet must accompany any chemicals brought onto the site.

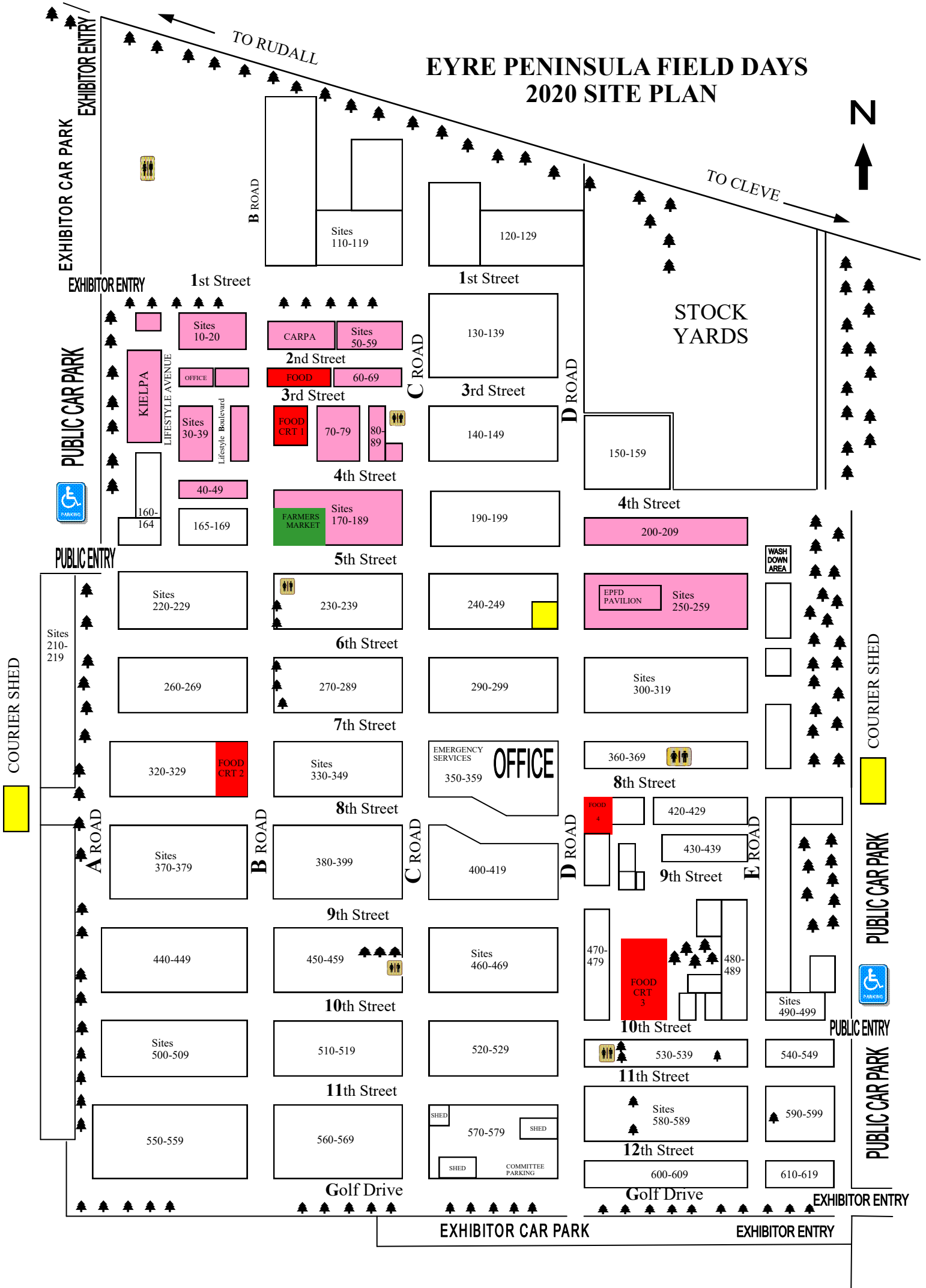

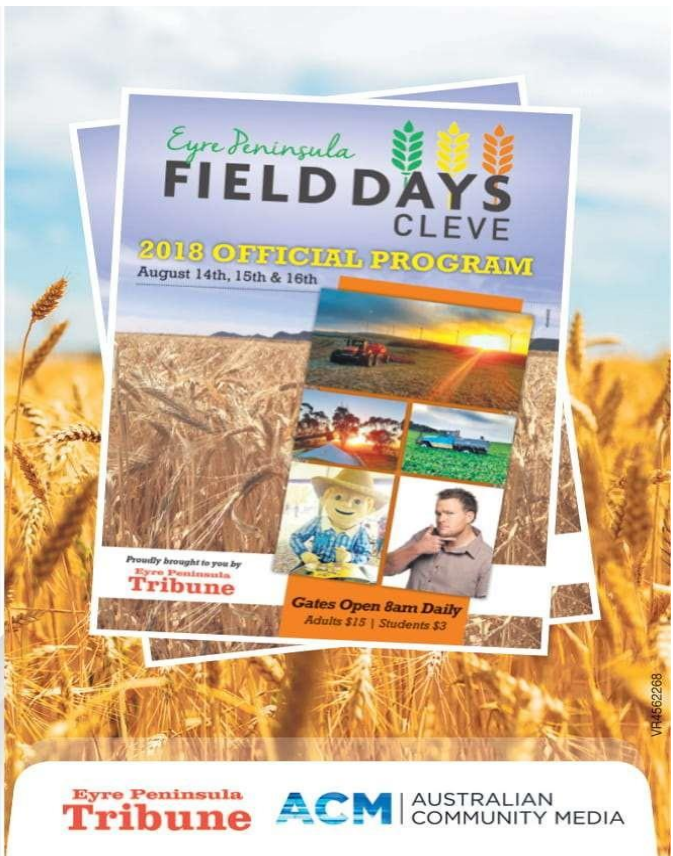

Site Application & Payment

All fees, as set out herein, must accompany an application form. In the case of static exhibits, agent or dealers taking a stand, all exhibitors on the said stand, nominated and entered, must be paid for by the exhibitor concerned. The main site holder is responsible for application fees.

Public Liability Insurance

Public Liability Insurance for Exhibitors sites is incorporated in the site fees. (Up to fifty million dollars cover with AON Services Aust.)

Amplifiers & Loudspeakers

Amplifiers and loudspeakers are strictly prohibited.

Excessive Noise

The Committee reserves the right to regulate the use of machinery on static display sites which produce excessive noise causing annoyance to other exhibitors and the public.

Offensive Material

The Committee of the Field Days shall have the power to enter on the area described at any time and remove articles, signs, pictures or printed matter, which in their opinion may be a cause of offence to the public or officials of the Committee.

Subletting or Sharing Sites

Except with the written consent previously obtained from the Committee, the exhibitor shall not assign or sublet or part with the possession of the whole or any part of the space or purport so to do.

Site Appearance

Exhibitors are responsible for the condition of the area covered by this Contract, during the EP Field Days and upon completion of such Field Days, exhibitors shall clean such area to the satisfaction of the Committee.

Liability & Acts of Parliament

Exhibitors hereby accept all responsibility for, and shall hold the Committee indemnified against any damage or injury to any person/s or property which may be occasioned by, or arise out of the use of any machinery, implement, or apparatus of any nature whatsoever used in connection with the stands and/or demonstration, and exhibitors hereby undertake to faithfully conform with the requirements of any Act of Parliament which may govern the erection of structures, displays and/or demonstrations and/or sales of machinery and other products, and also to conform with any regulations by-laws or rules made under such Acts of Parliament or by any Government, semi-Govt, or local Govt Authority duly authorised to make regulations, by-laws or rules in connection herewith. The Committee shall not be liable for any loss or damage to the exhibitor's property whilst on site. Over-night safety watch arrangements will be made by the Committee from 6pm Monday until 7.00am on Friday.

Cancellation of the Event

Equipment

Flag Poles

The Committee reserves the right to cancel this contract and to retain any money and in relation thereto if there is in the opinion of the Committee any infringement of any of the foregoing conditions and/or exhibitor does not occupy the space at the commencement of and during the full period of the said Field Days.

Cancellation by Exhibitor

Any exhibitor cancelling less than 21 working days prior to the event will not receive a refund unless the site can be suitably re-allocated. Cancellation must be received in writing. Site Fees include a compulsory \$100 cancellation fee which is non-refundable.
